Renewal of DACA

DACA cases with expiration dates up to 18 months in the future will be accepted. **Renewal fees will be covered — paid by a grant from the State of California.** Appointment recommended but not required.



Naturalization

- Free legal representation.
- Waiver of government fees for applicants with low incomes.

- VAWA and U Visa
- Adjustment of Status
- Consultations and Investigations of Your Immigration History

- Social Security Card
- California Driver License/I.D.

Citizenship Requirements

- Copies of any criminal records (arrests, citations or any activity with law enforcement)
- California Driver's License/ Identification Card
- Valid Permanent Resident Card
- Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate
- Selective Services Registration
- Marriage Certificate
- Divorce Certificate
- All Passports – expired and current
- Addresses where you have lived in the past 5 years
- Employment for the past 5 years
- Dates of all trips outside of the United States for the past 5 years
